APPLYING FOR SCAMP 2023

Enrollment applications will be posted online beginning April 15th Priority enrollment will be given to scampers that meet one of the conditions below, and apply between April 15 - 22. Enrollment will begin April 24th Tier 1: SCAMPers that applied/attended Scamp 2022 and have settled all past balances owed Tier 2: SCAMPers that have attended 2018 or later, but did not apply for Scamp 2022 and have settled all past balances owed Tier 3: New applicants and SCAMPers that have attended prior to 2018 and have settled all past balances owed

NEW FOR 2023 ***IMPORTANT***

- Full tuition must be paid by May 22nd to finalize a spot for SCAMP this summer.
- Families applying for financial aid or using other funds to cover the cost of SCAMP must be up to date with all document/information requests involved in those processes by May 22nd to finalize a spot at SCAMP for this summer.
- SCAMPers offered a spot after May lst will be offered an extended deadline communicated individually at the time a spot is offered.
