He started going when he was in elementary school and stayed with the program until he was 18. My daughter also started volunteering at SCAMP as soon as she was old enough. When I was asked if I wanted to be on the Board I was thrilled to have the opportunity to be involved in a program that has been so important to my family.

What is your favorite thing about SCAMP?

One of my favorite things about SCAMP is that it is such a big part of our community. It is not just the SCAMPers that love SCAMP, but it is also the volunteers and other staff. Many of our volunteers are Clarkston Community School students. Many of them, because of their experience with SCAMP have become Speech Pathologists, Special ED teachers, Paraprofessionals and Physical or Occupational therapists. Because SCAMP is community based, it helped my son and other SCAMPERS feel like they are an important part of our community.

My other favorite thing about SCAMP is that we accept anyone into the camp no matter how severe their disability. We provide the staff to make sure they are safe and have fun! We understand how expensive it is to raise and take care of a person with a disability and so we fundraise so we can keep the cost to less than one half of the camp's actual cost.

Meeting and getting to know all the wonderful and dedicated people who support SCAMP.

What do/did you do for a living?

I am an attorney. I quit practicing after my son was diagnosed with Autism.
