SCAMP was established in 1977

This year marks our 41st anniversary for the Walk and Roll.

What is SCAMP?

SCAMP is a five-week summer day camp program for children and young adults with disabilities. SCAMP supports individuals with a wide range of special needs including autism spectrum disorders, physical disabilities, and cognitive or emotional impairment. SCAMP has been a part of the Clarkston community for over 40 years although SCAMPers from all over southeastern Michigan attend our program. We serve over two hundred SCAMPers each year.

While SCAMP is under the direction of Clarkston Schools, all funding is provided by private donors and fundraisers held throughout the year. More than half of our SCAMPers require financial aid to attend. No child has ever been turned away for financial reasons.

For five weeks, our SCAMPers are challenged to grow in abilities and self-esteem and "to be the best they can be."

SCAMP creates an atmosphere filled with joy, compassion and friendship. The program concentrates on developing positive self-image, offering social interaction, and developing motor skills. Daily activities include music, art, swimming and water sports, field trips, gym, and outdoor play. The staff includes certified teachers, adult aides, student aides and community volunteers.
